DESIGNED FOR BOYS

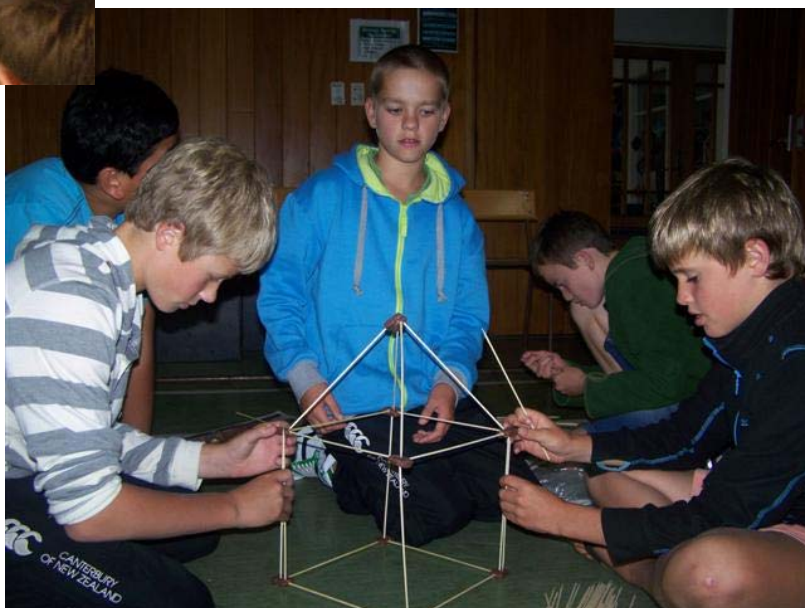
Dear Parents,
