Poor Andrew! It was really cold and everyone had to wear full diving kit. Not all people wore head thingies (hoods) though so some boys got cold ears!



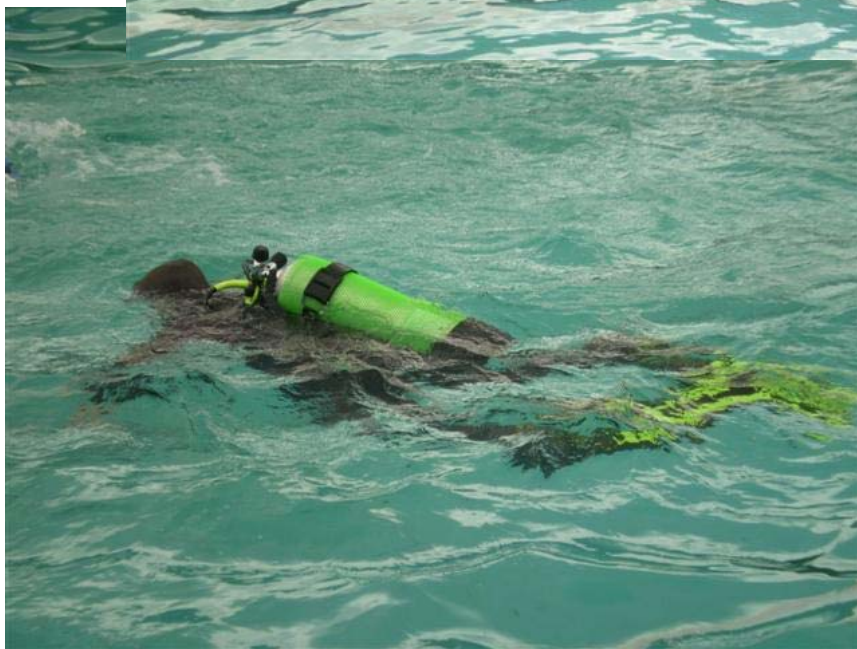
This is me, George.
