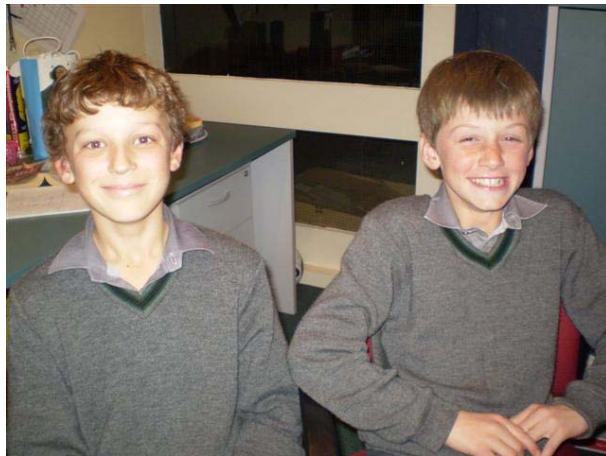


Today William Gunson was awarded his full rugby colors. We're all happy for him.
