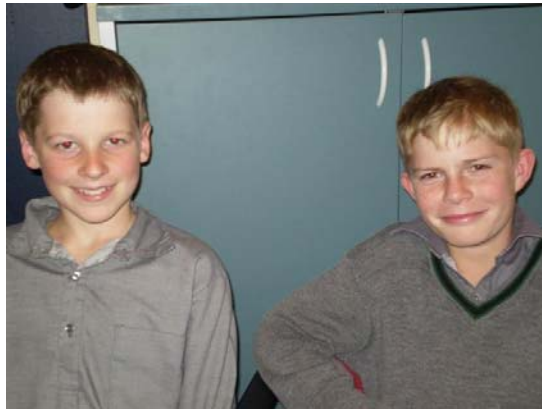
Last night we had the first of the class plays, the Year 7's. The Year 5 & 6 class plays are tomorrow night and the Year 8's on Thursday night.
