## Boarding Update: Term Two: # 8

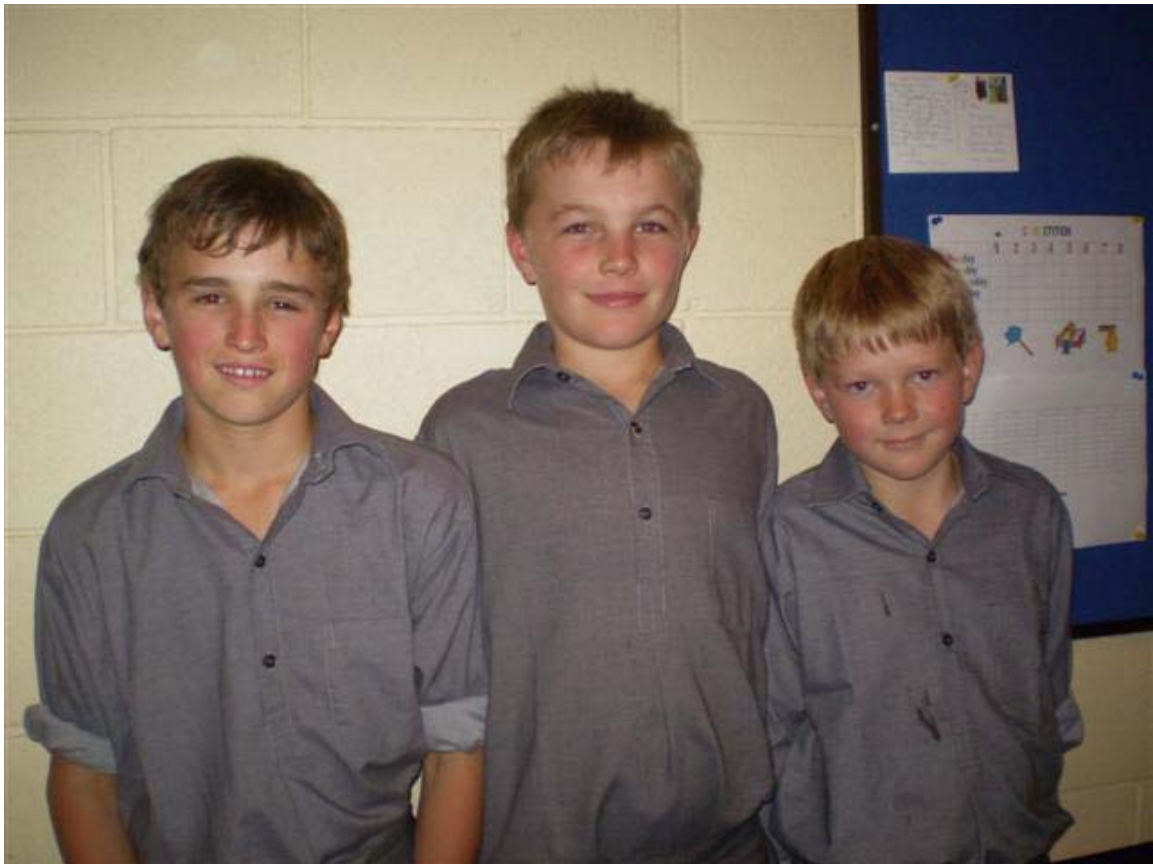
Dear Parents,
