- 3 Double check your name, email address, password, and username to make sure all fields are correct.
- 4 You may be asked to complete a Captcha. Fill in the words that are shown to let us know that you're human!
- 5 Success! You now have a Twitter account.

Linking to your mobile phone:

- 1 Browse the **Who to follow** tab for users, type in Hereworth School in the search field. (Ensure you follow the official Hereworth School twitter account, there will be recent tweets on the account).
- 2 Clicking the '**Follow**' button next to username will add them to the list of users you follow.
- 3 You then want to link your twitter account to your mobile phone. Once you are following Hereworth School you will see a mobile phone icon. Click on this to enable the mobile phone feature.
